OIA TEMPORARY RULE 4

On March 20, 2020, the OIA, in concurrence with the Chair of the AOB, enacted 11 temporary rules to address COVID-19 concerns. All but one of the temporary rules have been lifted over the course of the last two years.

Temporary Rule 4 was recently re-enacted with a slight modification and remains in effect. It provides neutral arbitrators with the authority to serve decisions and/or orders electronically to the OIA, rather than by mail. (Rule 39.)
